Joe A. Aceves, P.E.

Joe Aceves has more than 36 years of experience in public works and water utilities. He began his career working for the City of San Antonio in 1970, where he held various positions including Assistant Director of the Public Works Department (1978-1984); Director of the Wastewater Management Department (1984-1986); and finally Director of the Public Works Department (1988-1992). From 1986-1988, he worked as Executive Vice-President and later President of Lackland City Water Company at Ellison Industries in San Antonio and in 1992 he joined the San Antonio Water System as President and CEO where he retired in 1997.

In 1997, Mr. Aceves began working as a consultant and established his own company, Joe A. Aceves, P.E. Municipal, Water Utilities, and Development Consulting Services. He has also worked for two consulting firms, Operational Technologies Environmental Group (OpTech) and Turner Collie and Braden Inc. He became the Executive Director the Infrastructure Services Department for Bexar County in January 2006.

He holds a bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering from Texas A&M University and is a Licensed Professional Engineer in the State of Texas. He has had past membership in the following associations: National, Texas, and Bexar Societies of Professional Engineers, American Water Works Association, Texas Association of Private Water and Sewer Companies, Greater San Antonio Chamber of Commerce, Institute of Transportation Engineers, and is currently a member of the American Public Works Association.
